Additionally, the company is rolling out its aura health and beauty brand at the club with four treatment rooms (two ensuite), a manicure room and a spray tan facility which will operate using Fake Bake tanning products. There is also a relaxation room with luxury loungers, a celestial ceiling, subtle background music and a water feature where clients can relax in between treatments. This is available to members & non members and there are day packages available. Aura will use the Clarins, Espa and Jessica Nails product houses.
